

In the Will of John Coppock late of
Albacutya Station in the West Wimmera District
in the Colony of Victoria Sheep farmer deceased

I John Coppock White of Albacutya Station in the
West Wimmera District in the Colony of Victoria
Sheep farmer make Oath and say

1. That I believe the annexed Paper writing marked
"A" to be the true last Will of John Coppock late of
Albacutya Station in the West Wimmera District in
the Colony of Victoria Sheep farmer deceased.
2. That I will pay all his debts and Legacies as far
as the property left by him will extend and the Law
bind me so to do.
- 2 3. That I will exhibit or full and true Inventory of
all his property together with a true account of my
administration thereof into the Registry of this
Honorable Court when lawfully required
4. That I believe his property does not exceed in value
Fifteen thousand Pounds.

This is the last Will and Testament
of me John Coppock of Abacutya
North of Lake Hindmarsh District
of Wirrimeria. Via Rosham. Squatter.
or Sheep Farmer in the Colony of
Victoria after payment of
all my just Debts Funeral Expenses and
Testamentary expenses I give devise
and bequeath unto my Nephew Alfred-
James White the Sum of £500. Five Hundred
Pounds also to my Niece Susanna Evans
White the Sum of £500. Five Hundred Pounds
and as to the residue and remainder
of all my real and personal Estate I
give and devise and bequeath the same
unto my Nephew John Coppock White
and I hereby appoint my Nephew
John Coppock White the sole Executor
of this my Will

this day June 30th 1864
